Longwood Gardens – To See the \$90M Refurbished Light Show!!

What can we say!! The BRAND NEW and MOST SPECTACULAR light & fountain show ever!! This Longwood Gardens feature has been closed for 2-1/2 years – and now it's finished and open!! The show includes 30 new propane-laced flame jets and brand new jets of water that SPIN! There are basket-weave fountain displays -- never seen before in the world and designed just for Longwood Gardens!! This amazing feature opens on Memorial Day weekend so if you haven't seen it by August, be sure to join us.

Here's the scoop: Cost is \$23 for adults, students & seniors (62+) \$20, youths 5 to 18 \$12 and under 5 free. You need to order **TIMED ENTRY TICKETS** -- there are 300 tickets available for each half hour so you can decide when you want to enter. We are going to see the light show at 9:15 -- the only one with LIGHTS since it is the only one in darkness! (Other fountain shows are at 11, 1, 3, 5, and 7 p.m.)

To order your own tickets (a must for MLSC'ers!), either order online at www.longwoodgardens.org OR by phone at 610-388-1000 BUT there is a \$6 fee per order (not per ticket so if you are ordering for 2 or more, the \$6 fee isn't so bad).

Over 100 of Andrew Wyeth's paintings will be on display this summer, viewed in chronological order, at the Brandywine River Museum on Route 1 in Chadds Ford. The only other venue for this exhibit will be Seattle so be sure not to miss this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity!

The museum opens at 9:30 a.m. and the cost is \$15 for adults, \$10 for seniors. They recommend getting there as early as possible though they say that everyone will definitely get in! We're saying 10:30 to 11:00 to arrive, though you can also come earlier.

At approximately 1 p.m., we will then have lunch at the nearby *Agave Restaurant* which specializes in Mexican cuisine (quesadillas, tacos, enchiladas, burritos, \$10 to \$20).

The museum is easy to find on Route 1 in Chadds Ford. Coming from the Philadelphia area, it is on the left, just before the Brandywine Creek.

Directions to Ralph's, 138 Orchard Way, Berwyn 19312:

From Rt. 30/Lancaster Pike, At the Berwyn traffic light go over the bridge to Old Lancaster Pike/Bridge Rd. Go around the curve and make the first right at the stop sign onto Howellville Road. In just 0.2 miles, there is a traffic light at Conestoga Rd., with T.E. Middle School on your left. Orchard Way is dead ahead, just slightly to the right. It is **ONE WAY**.

Ralph's house is the THIRD house on the left, a gray trimmed saltbox. There is room for only a few cars in the driveway and there is limited parking on Orchard Way. It is recommended to park at the Middle School (turn left at the light onto Conestoga, then a left into the parking lot. Go down the concrete steps at the intersection and cross the street for the short walk to Orchard Way and Ralph's house.) If a driver drops people off at Ralph's driveway on Orchard Way, follow Orchard Way to dead end on Bair, turn right, then turn right again on Conestoga to get back to the intersection -- continue through

intersection a short distance and turn left into school parking lot.

From KOP - Rt. 202 south: Take the Rt. 252 South/Paoli exit and turn left at the FIRST light onto Cassatt Road. Follow Cassatt up to the Conestoga Road intersection above and make a sharp left to Orchard Way OR turn right onto Conestoga, then go left to park in the Middle School parking lot.
